

## Visual & Written Art Contest



The ATA Local #18 - Diversity, Equity, and Human Rights (DEHR) Committee is holding a creative art contest open to ALL students of the Wetaskiwin Regional Public School Division.

The purpose of this contest is to advance knowledge, develop skills, and foster inclusion among our students. In keeping with the ATA mission to provide a foundation of learning, developing the citizens of our society, and maximizing the potentials and gifts of each child, the contest will be divided among five categories in order to minimize the potential advantages of older students. Each category will have a guiding requirement and awards will be determined according to the following criteria;

- Alignment of composition to the concept/theme
- Originality
- Creativity

The contest will commence December 1<sup>st</sup>, and submissions may be submitted until closing on March 23, 2017. Top submissions in each category will be announced April 20, 2017, and posted on the ATA Local 18 website with a brief write up and photo of the student, and winning entries may be submitted to local media/ATA News for publication. Each division will be reviewed separately, and the DEHR committee will forward the top 5 submissions for each category for final selections. To be considered for an award, students will need to accompany their submission with the following entry form and FOIP form.

Awards will be distributed as follows;

Three Grand Prizes	- School Board Prize, \$150 gift card - Superintendent Prize, \$100 gift card - Local President Prize, \$100 gift card
Division 1 (Grades K-3)	- Top Prize, a class pizza party -Runners up (2), cookies for the class
Division 2 (Grades 4-6)	- Top Prize, a class pizza party -Runners up (2), cookies for the class
Division 3 (Grades 7-9)	- Top Prize, \$50.00 gift card -Runners up (2), \$25.00 gift card
Division 4 (Grades 10+)	- Top Prize, \$50.00 gift card -Runners up (2), \$25.00 gift card
Alternate Education Programs (K-12)	- Top Prize, a class pizza party -Runners up (2), cookies for the class
