WETASKIWIN LOCAL No. 18 <u>TEACHER BOARD ADVISORY COMMITTEE</u> Frame of Reference

The Teacher Board Advisory Committee is a Wetaskiwin Alberta Teachers' Association Local No. 18 Committee established to maintain communication between the ATA Local and the Wetaskiwin Regional Public Schools. It will strive to improve the level of communication, trust, and morale within the school district.

- 1. The committee shall be called the Wetaskiwin ATA Local Teacher-Board Advisory Committee.
- 2. Three teacher representatives to the T.B.A.C will be elected at a general meeting. This committee will elect a chair for the committee.
- 3. Terms of office for members of this committee shall be for one year.
- 4. Status of this Committee: As an advisory committee it may make recommendations to the Board on any matters that pertain to the educational enterprise, and particularly those that are directly associated with improving the educational enterprise.
- 5. General
 - A. The ATA Committee members will bring forward any teacher concerns that affect their function in their positions as teachers.
 - B. Matters that are under negotiation between the Board and ATA Local may generally not be discussed.
 - C. The ATA Local will provide a budget line to cover reasonable expenses to teacher board members
